

## Beau Geste Stair Tower Guide

1. Wind wheels into base of frame marked 'bottom'
2. Attach one end horizontal braces "A" and "B"
3. Stand up other frame marked "bottom"
4. Attach other end of horizontal braces marked "A" and "B"
5. Attach long diagonal beam marked "D" and long diagonal beam marked "C"
6. Attach stair ladder marked "E"
7. Attach outriggers to each corner and adjust clamps to steady the structure
8. Attach horizontal beam marked "F"
9. Attach floor piece labelled "H"
10. Place frame marked "J" on top of base frame attach one end of horizontal "H" beam
11. Whilst holding the frame, a second person places frame marked "K" on top of base frame and attach the other end of the horizontal "H" to the second frame
12. Attach horizontal beam marked "L"
13. Place a spare short horizontal beam in centre slot marked "safety" – this is temporary for safety in the next step, then take out when it is needed or climber is comfortable
14. Place frame marked "U" into top of middle frame
15. Attach long diagonal beam marked "R" onto marked spot, securing the "U" frame
16. Place frame marked "V" on the other side
17. Attach horizontal beams marked "N" and "Q" to secure top frame
18. Attach stair ladder marked "M"
19. Attach diagonal beams marked "O" and "P" parallel with stairs
20. Place floor piece marked "T" onto top frame opposite and above stair ladder
21. Place floor piece with hinge door marked "S" next to top floor piece
22. Place horizontal beam marked "W" and "X" on hinge floorboard side
23. Attach skirting board onto top floor with opening facing the boat and cable tie in place
